On April 27, 1966, the Commission issued Order No. 56203, designating the service areas of electric utilities in the State of Maryland with certain minor exceptions.

On November 23, 1999, the Baltimore Gas and Electric Company ("BGE") and the Potomac Electric Power Company ("PEPCO") requested authority to transfer from PEPCO to BGE the service area for a new industrial park on Trolley Lane in Prince George's County as indicated on the area map that accompanied the petition.

In a memorandum dated November 23, 1999, Technical Staff noted PEPCO's cost to provide service to the industrial park would be more than \$300,000 greater than BGE's cost. Also, service to existing customers will not be affected. Based on these reasons, Staff recommended that the requested boundary change be granted.

After considering this matter at the December 1, 1999 Administrative Meeting, the Commission approved the requested change to the service area boundary of BGE and PEPCO.

IT IS, THEREFORE, this 1st day of December, in the year Nineteen Hundred and Ninety-nine, by the Public Service Commission of Maryland,

ORDERED: (1) That the request of Baltimore Gas and Electric Company and the Potomac Electric Power Company for approval of a revision to their mutual service area boundary south of Ammendale Road in Prince George's County as requested is hereby granted.

(2) That both the Baltimore Gas and Electric Company and the Potomac Electric Power Company shall file with the Commission two (2) United States Geological Survey Beltsville quadrangle maps clearly delineating the service area boundary change.
